

## Fees for vital records

### VITAL STATISTICS (Sec.7-73,7-74,7-76):

Marriage license	<b><u>\$50.00**</u></b> of which \$34.00 is to be forwarded to the Department of Health Services by the 10 <sup>th</sup> day after the end of each calendar quarter
Short-form birth certificate	<b><u>\$ 15.00</u></b>
Certified copy of birth (long form), Death, marriage or Civil Union	<b><u>\$ 20.00*</u></b>
Burial or removal permit	<b><u>\$ 5.00**</u></b>
Cremation permit	<b><u>\$ 5.00**</u></b>
Copies to other towns (If the bill for such copies is less than \$26.00, no bill shall be sent.)	<b><u>\$ 2.00</u></b>

In accordance with Connecticut state law, the Town Clerk/Registrar of Vital Statistics must ascertain as accurately as possible, all births, deaths and marriages which occur in the town, and must record them in books kept for these purposes.

Permits for burials, cremations and disinterment are issued from the office.
