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A meeting of the Human Services Committee was held on Monday, March 20, 2023. This was a hybrid meeting held both in person and electronically via ZOOM. The meeting was called to order at 7:42 PM by Vice- Chair, Adrian Webber.

Public Input: No speakers

The following items were addressed:

1. Appointment of William M. MacMullen to the Veterans Commission for a term to expire October 26, 2025. (U-4)

--Moved by Mr. Anthony and seconded by Ms. Kiely. A vote was taken. The item passed unanimously.

2. Appointment of Greta Johnson as an alternate to the Fair Rent Commission for a term to expire June 30, 2024. (D-3)

--Moved by Mr. Webber and seconded by Ms. Sweet. DISCUSSION: Mr. Farmer supports this appointment. A vote was taken. The item passed unanimously.

3. Appointment and reappointment of Jennifer Coggins as a citizen member to the Fair Rent Commission for an appointment expiring June 30, 2023 and a reappointment to expire June 30, 2026. (D-4)

--Moved by Ms. Sweet and seconded by Ms. Kiely. A vote was taken. The item passed unanimously.

4. Appointment of Tanisha Thomas Asbery to the Community Development Citizens Advisory Commission for a term to expire March 31, 2025. (D-1)

--Moved by Mr. Anthony and seconded by Ms. Kiely. A vote was taken. The item passed unanimously.

5. Appointment of Stephen White to the Greater New Haven Transit district for a term to expire March 31, 2027.

--Moved by Ms. Sweet and seconded by Mr. O'Brien. A vote was taken. The item passed unanimously.

6. Appointment of Daniel W. Kops, Jr. as an alternate to the Greater New Haven Transit District for a term expiring March 31, 2027

--Moved by Mr. Webber and seconded by Mr. Anthony. A vote was taken. The item passed unanimously.

7. Reappointment of Wendy Weeks to the Human Services Commission for a term to expire March 1, 2025.

--Moved by Mr. Anthony and seconded by Ms. Sweet. A vote was taken. The item passed unanimously.

8. Order to accept and expend grant funds and enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with University of Massachusetts, Worcester, Network of National Library of Medicine Region 7

-- Moved by Mr. Anthony and seconded by Ms. Sweet. DISCUSSION: Library Director Melissa Canham-Clyne explained this is a grant in collaboration with a small non-profit related to the quality of indoor air. These are individual CO2 monitors. Mr. Anthony asked if these are strictly for the Library. Ms. Canham-Clyne said these are 10 individual monitors which will be lent out to the public, like other Library items. Mr. Farmer thanked Ms. Canham-Clyne for all she does. Mr. Webber thanked Ms. Canham-Clyne for all she does.

A vote was taken. The item passed unanimously.
