### **CALL TO ORDER**

Mr. Minkema called the meeting to order at 7:09 p.m.

### **Unfinished Business**

- a. Hamden Cemeteries – Mr. Griego mentioned that there is no grant writer in town at this time so he will contact the Mayor's Office to determine how to move forward on obtaining information on the grant for cemeteries. He also mentioned that the cleanup of State Street Cemetery is scheduled for April 10, 2021.

- b. Local Register Properties – As mentioned in the minutes from the informal meeting which took place on September 21, 2020 a Mr. George Schneider the Membership Director of the Spring Glen Civic Association has been in touch with members of the committee in regards to meeting to move forward a conversation regarding the designation of Spring Glen as a historic district. Mr. Levine reported that he did attend a meeting with the Spring Glen Association on November 10, 2020. He presented them with information regarding the local register district and state register, etc. and answered their questions. The members of the Association stated that they would talk amongst themselves to determine how to move forward. Mr. Levine will continue to move forward with the grant work.
- c. Ives House – Ms. Julie Smith from the Mayor’s Office has been assisting with special projects and she has been in contact with Mr. Levine regarding the Ives House. She has confirmed that there are no funds to put into The Ives House. He asked for further information regarding things that had been agreed upon prior and has yet to hear back. He has emailed Ms. Smith to ask for an update. As previously mentioned, Mr. Levine believes that putting a new roof on the house will save the property. Mr. Levine reached out to RWA regarding what can be done about the Ives House, he has yet to hear back.
- d. Dickerman House – Mr. Minkema stated that the roof is in the process of being shingled. There have been two bids for the survey and planning grant and there are inquiries out to firms.
