LEGAL NOTICE TO HAMDEN TAXPAYERS

The second installment of taxes levied on the Grand List of October 1, 2019 is due and payable January 1, 2021. The Supplemental Motor Vehicle Tax levied under CGS 12-71b is due and payable in a single installment on January 1, 2021.

If these taxes are not paid on or before April 1, 2021, they will be subject to interest at the rate of 1 1/2% per month or fraction thereof from the due date of January 1, 2021, to the date the tax installment is paid. (This extended deadline does NOT apply to Escrow Payments or to Landlords who have not applied for and been approved for the extended deadline. Those payments must be received on or before February 1, 2021, to avoid interest.) The minimum interest charge is \$2.00.

These taxes become delinquent April 2, 2021. (Escrowed accounts will become delinquent on February 2, 2021, as well as Landlords who did not apply for and get approved for the extended deadline.) In accordance with a Town Ordinance all delinquent motor vehicle taxes requiring a release for motor vehicle registration must be paid by cash, certified check or money order. Taxes will be received at the Office of the Tax Collector, Hamden Government Center, 2750 Dixwell Ave, Hamden, Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM. While the building is closed to the public, an outside drop box is available for check or money order payments only. You may also pay by mail or online at www.hamden.com. We have no means to accept cash payments at this time.
