CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT – MUNCHKIN/RASCALS/BROOKSVALE

I will be expected to:

- Follow ALL Covid-19 guidelines set forth in all camps.
- Show respect by treating other campers and adults the way I want to be treated
- Always stay within the boundaries of camp, within eyesight of counselors.
- Ask for counselor’s permission before using restroom or leaving my group.
- Be a friend that others can trust.
- Remain seated while bus is in motion.
- Follow all directions given by the bus driver, including seat assignment.
- Enter the bus in an orderly fashion, proceed immediately to a seat and remain seated until their destination is reached.
- The bus driver has the authority to assign seats.
- Be respectful of staff by listening and following instructions.
- Be respectful of campers. No fighting, insulting, teasing or bullying. No rough play.
- Accept other campers eager to join in activity. Share equipment and supplies.
- Be a good sport, whether I win or lose.
- Never touch or take anything that does not belong to me.
- Use appropriate and acceptable language.
- Dress in appropriate clothing. (No open toes shoes allowed)
- Leave valuables home (cell phones, tablets, etc.)
- Cooperate with other campers & staff.
- Accept the consequences of my actions.

I understand that there will be consequences for any negative behavior.

- Letter of discipline for talking back, destroying property, bullying others, disrupting the program, and refusing to following directions/instructions. Parents/guardians will be required to sign reports acknowledging that they have read the report. After three reports child and parent may be required to meet with the Camp Directors Staff.
- Letter of discipline and immediate suspension for a minimum of one day for hitting, kicking, biting, spitting, scratching, swearing, making degrading or racial remarks, or leaving the group. Parent may be required to meet with the Camp Directors before the child can return to the program.
- Camp services may also be terminated if the parent is physically or verbally abusive to a staff member. It is our desire that every child enjoys his/her experience in the program.
- Participation in the Summer Camps program may be limited or discontinued if this contract is not followed.

SOME BEHAVIORS MAY WARRANT CHANGING THE ABOVE PROCEDURES DEPENDING UPON THE SEVERITY OF THE INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR.
