

**Tax Season is underway and the forms are now available for patrons to pick up at all Hamden Public Library locations.**

We currently offer:

**Federal:** Forms 1040, 1040 SR & Instruction Book 1040/1040-SR from the Federal Government.

**State:** the state no longer sends us anything, so we have printed copies of the CT Resident 1040, CT Non-Resident/Part-Year Resident 1040 to take.

**Wireless Printing:** Individuals may print documents out at the library using their own devices and our WIFI. Print jobs can be sent from home to the library! Regular print charges apply: 15 cents for black and white and 50 cents for color ink.

**Borrow those complicated instructions:** Library patrons may borrow binders with tax instructions at the Information Services Desk in Miller and at our branches, Brundage Community – 91 Circular and Whitneyville 128 Carleton.

Also, library staff is able to print out most other tax forms as needed.

The library's Digital Navigators are available for one-on-one assistance to help individuals with any tax related website or digital issue, including how to file online. Please call for an appointment: 959-261-0689.

VITA is helping people in three ways:

- In Person at the High School this year from January 30-April 17. Monday & Wednesday from 5-7:30 P.M. and Saturday from 10 AM - 1:30 P.M. Closed 2/8, 2/20 & 4/12 and whenever the school is closed for weather. Masks required.
- Drop off: Taxpayers come to the high school, fill out the intake form, and leave the form, along with your tax documents, with the VITA greeter at the reception table. Taxpayer comes back a week later to sign the completed documents.
